

**STANDING RULES GOVERNING SCHOLARSHIPS
(As revised May, 2004)**

THE PHYLLIS V. ROBERTS SCHOLARSHIP

The Scholarship is named for Phyllis V. Roberts, the second Virginian to serve as President of GFWC, 1986-88. The Phyllis V. Roberts Scholarship Fund shall consist of contributions from clubs and individuals given for the purpose of awarding scholarships to college students in a subject field selected by each administration. The 2018-2020 scholarship will be awarded to an undergraduate or graduate student who best exemplifies the GFWC motto "Living the Volunteer Spirit". The goal is to promote community service by identifying a community agency or organization with a specific need and implementing a project or program aimed at meeting that need. The Scholarship Committee will administer the scholarship fund.

1. Applicant must be a Virginia resident.
2. Letters of reference from three (3) individuals – one of a general nature, two recommendations from recent teachers, counselors, advisors or professors -- must accompany the application.
3. Applicant must have at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA verified by a transcript from most recent school attended accompanying application.
4. Applicant shall document how they were involved with a program or project that addressed a need in the community.
5. Applicant shall indicate the degree program and concentration area being pursued.
6. Applicant should include a resume of educational and employment history as well as community service and awards received.

Scholarships totaling \$3,000 may be given during 2018-2020. A scholarship of \$1,000 per year may be awarded each recipient. A recipient may re-apply. All monies will be paid directly to the Virginia College/University, where the student attends, after receipt of verification that the applicant is a registered student.
