

GFWC VIRGINIA JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY

The Junior Honor Society is recognition of a club's high level of participation in Federation activities, particularly those that are directly sponsored by the Junior organization. All work must have been accomplished during the club year January 1 – December 31. **In order to qualify, you must meet a minimum point level for each section.** A participation award will be given to clubs that do not meet the minimum criteria. Qualifying clubs will receive special recognition at the GFWC Virginia Convention, according to the level of achievement. There will be three award categories:

Participation Level:	Under 10 points or do not meet minimum criteria within areas
Bronze Level:	Minimum of 10 points total
Silver Level:	Minimum of 18 points total
Gold Level:	Minimum of 26 points total

Entries must be postmarked on or before **March 1**.
